



## SureStrike™ 12 Gauge Shotgun adapter User Guide

SureStrike Adapters let you apply the standard 9mm SureStrike laser dry fire training system to a specified weapon caliber.

### Step 1- Safety:

Unload the weapon. Physically and visually inspect the chamber, bore, and magazine well to ensure that all ammunition has been removed. Unload ammunition from any magazines that will be used in training. Store ammunition in an area that is separate from your training area.

- ⚠ Always personally verify that all ammunition has been removed before training.  
Do not allow any live ammunition in the training area.

**Warning – firearms can cause serious injuries or death**

### Step 2:

- Install the battery pack in the Laser Bullet as described in the SureStrike User Guide (Steps 1-2).
- Open the Shotgun Adapter by unscrewing the adapter cap. Separate the back and front end of your shotgun adaptor.
- insert the laser bullet into the body of the adapter end (the long part).
- reassemble the Adapter by screwing the cap back on and tightening gently.
- It is recommended to lightly lubricate the Shotgun Adapter's O – ring before use.



### Step 3:

- Open the chamber of the shotgun, rotate and align the grooves in the adaptor extraction rim to be positioned as an "X" in the chamber so that that the weapon's extractor will not come in contact with the adaptor's rim while cycling.
- Insert the Shotgun Adapter as you would insert a single cartridge
- Load the shell into your shotgun.



### Step 4 – Removal

- Open the chamber.
- Using your finger or a pencil, rotate the Shotgun Adapter by pushing the grooves on the adaptor's cap until it is aligned as a "+" in the chamber so that that the weapon's extractor WILL come in contact with the adaptor's rim. Cycle the weapon over a soft surface and eject the adaptor.
- Remove the Laser Bullet from the adaptor in the reverse of Step 2.
